Midwest Environmental Advocates joins the Wisconsin Department of Justice, the Department of Natural Resources and Clean Wisconsin in opposing the Legislature's request to intervene in our longstanding challenge to the Kinnard Farms water pollution permit. It would be improper and an unwise use of taxpayer resources for the Legislature to intervene using authority granted by lame duck statutes when that legislation that is currently the subject of a separate legal challenge.
