Pursuant to Judge Ehler's April 28, 2015, decision in the above-referenced matter, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) intends to modify the Wisconsin Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) Permit issued to Kinnard Farms, Inc. (Kinnard), under the supervision of the Division of Hearings and Appeals.

As required in the DNR Order dated October 29, 2014, DNR will amend the Permit to establish a maximum number of animal units at the facility and will amend the Permit to require a groundwater monitoring plan.

To that end, DNR requests that Kinnard provide DNR with a proposed maximum number of animal units for the current Permit term, along with a justification for that proposed number. DNR will review the number provided by Kinnard and determine the maximum number of animal units to be included in the Permit. Also, as required by the DNR Order, DNR requests Kinnard to submit additional information regarding its proposed groundwater monitoring plan. Kinnard must address the missing components of the plan, as identified in DNR's letter to Kinnard, dated March 19, 2015, including the requirement to include at least 2 monitoring wells to assess groundwater quality impacts from off-site landspreading, if practicable.
